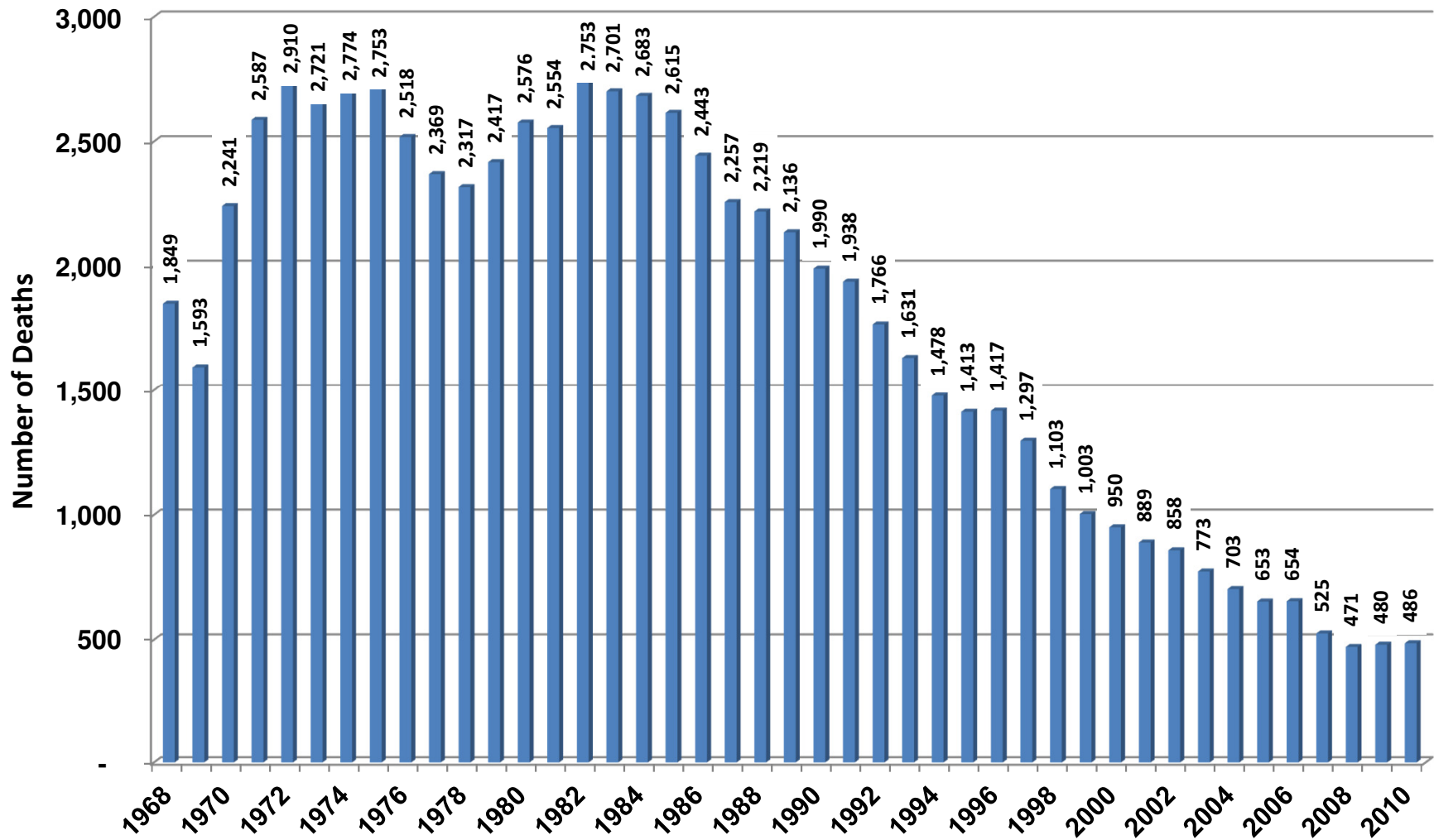

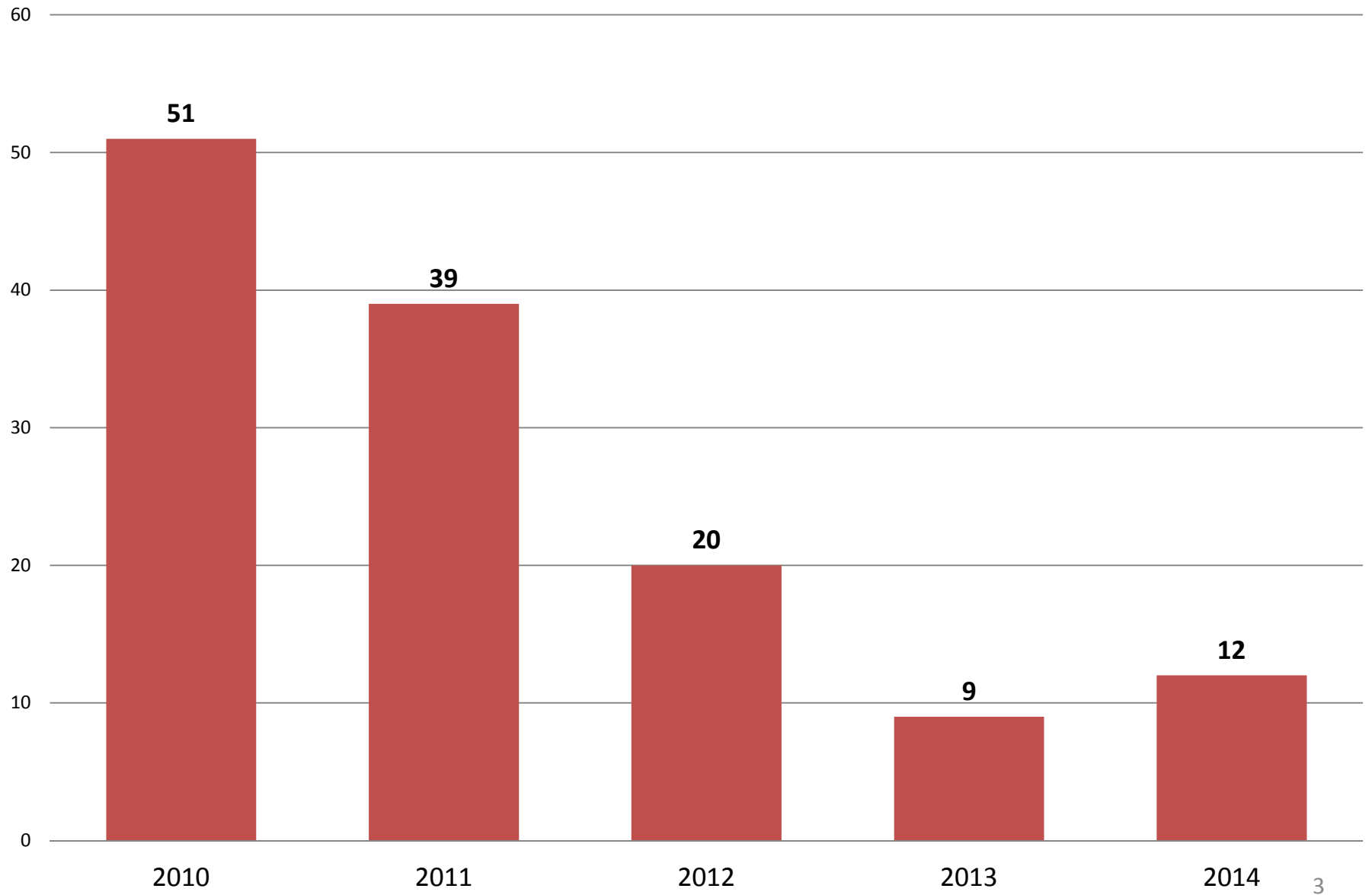
Number of Deaths due to CWP* (1968-2010)

■ Contributing and Underlying Causes of Death

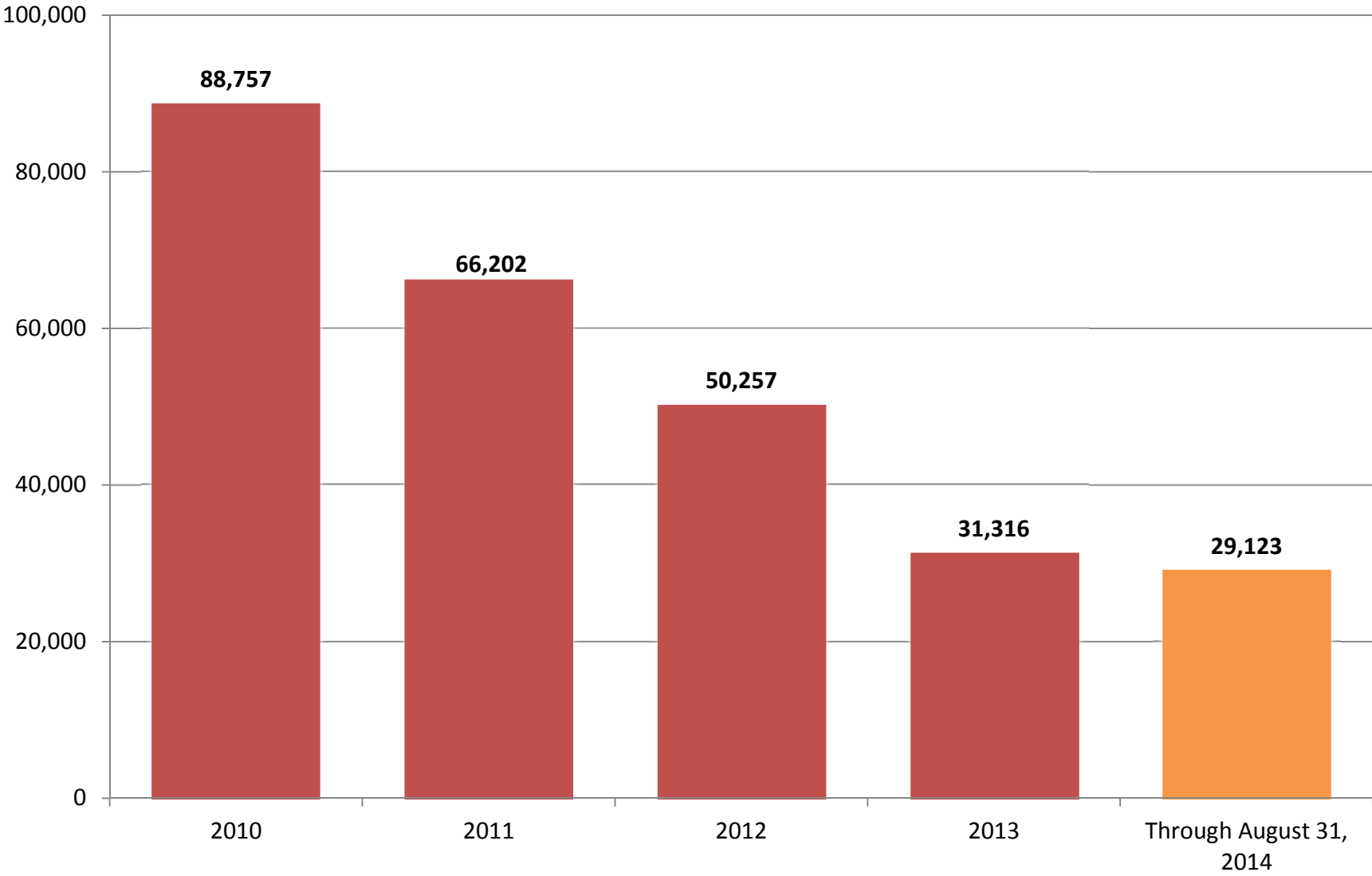

Number of Mines Identified in Pattern of Violations (POV) Screenings CY 2010-2014

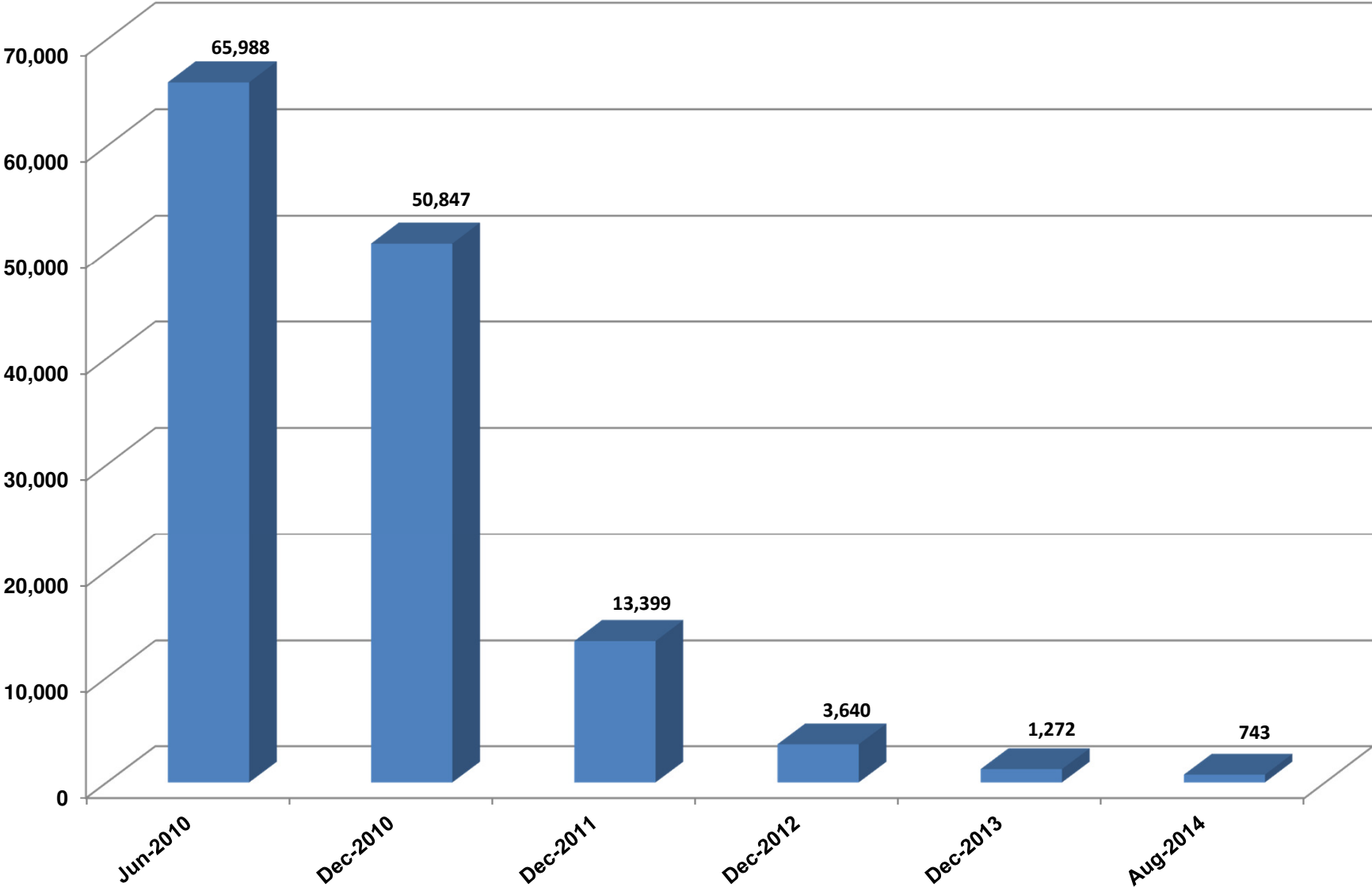


Number of Citations in Contest (Backlog) CY 2010-2014

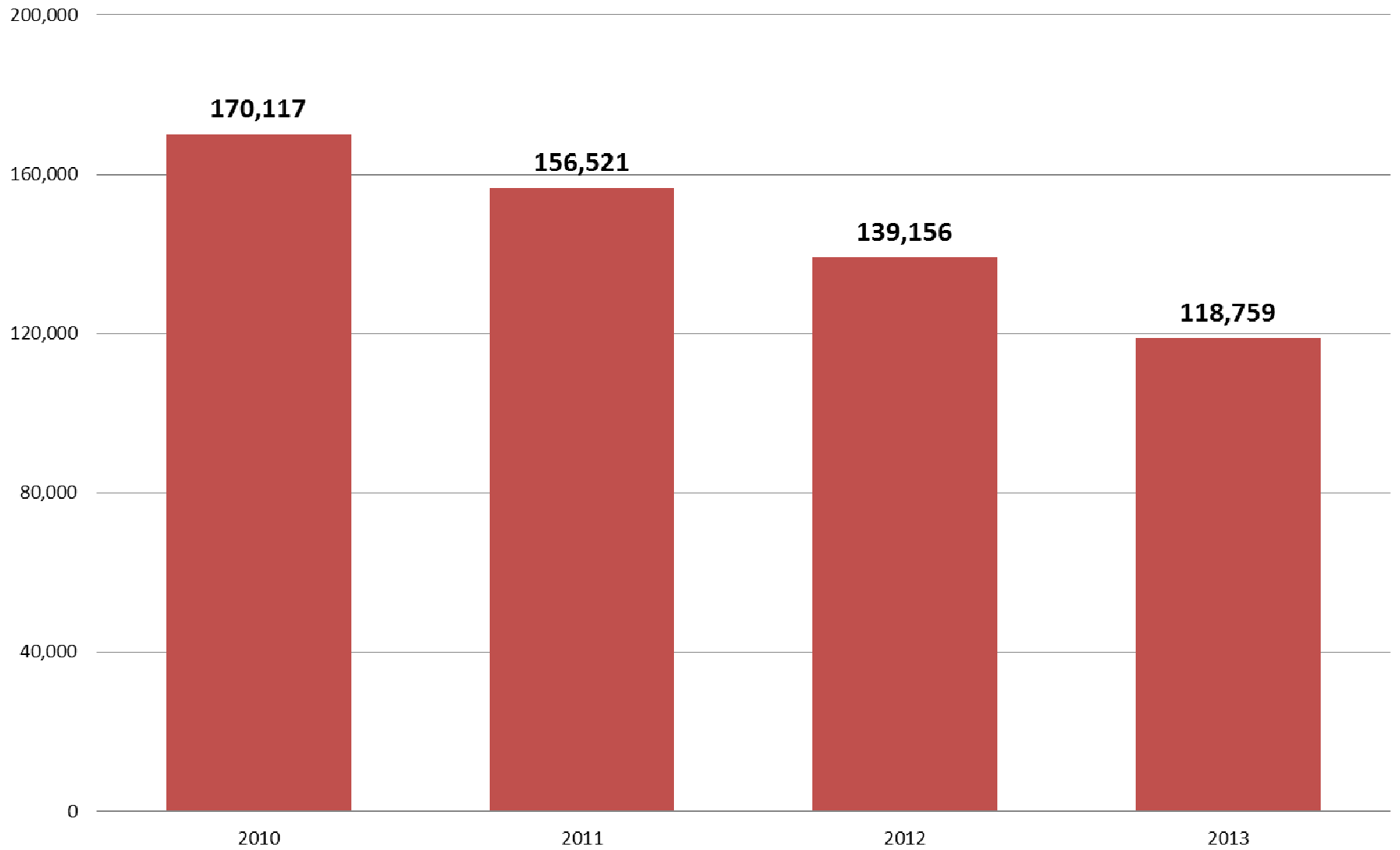


Targeted Backlog

■ Number of Citations In Contest

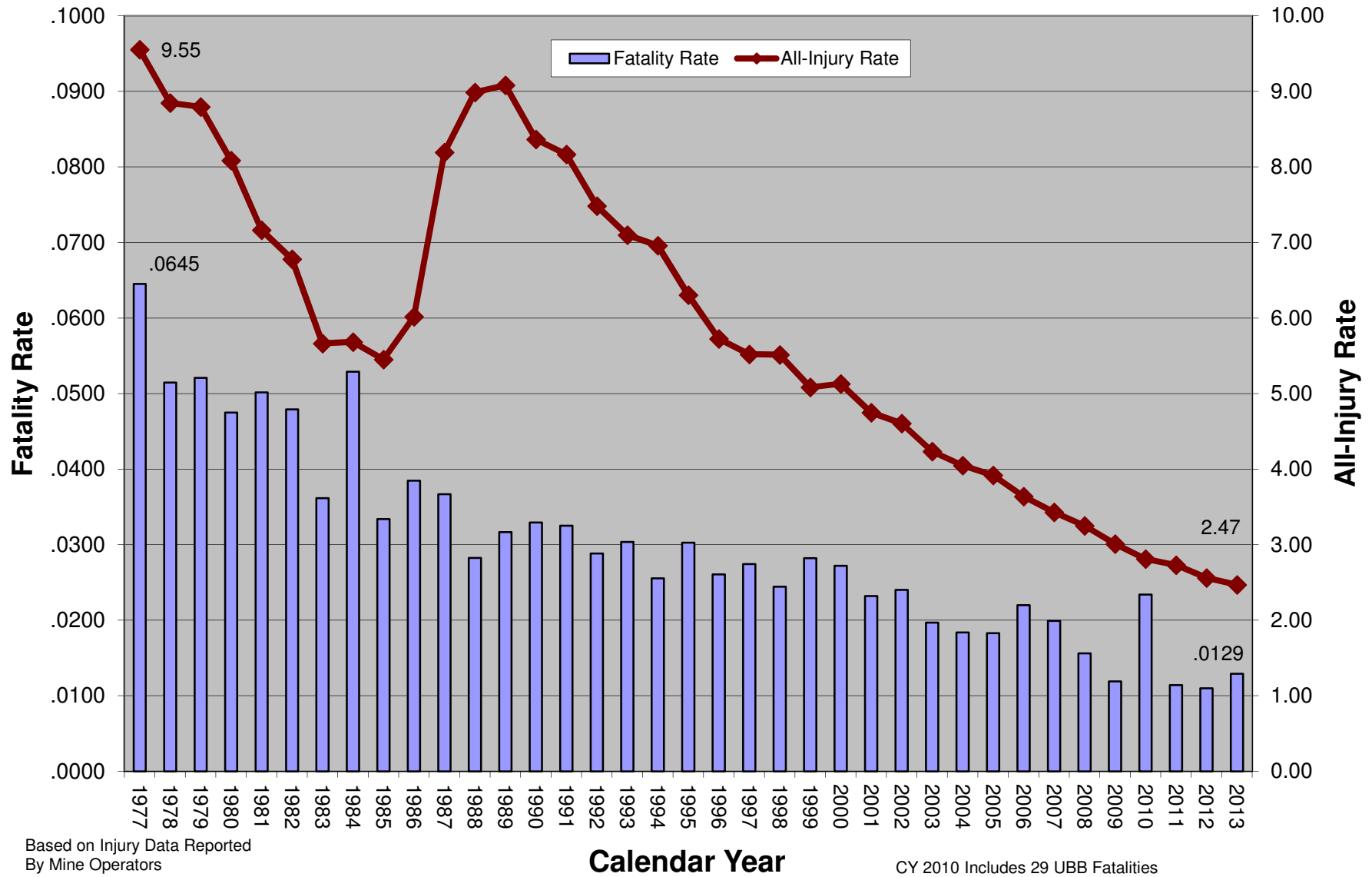


US Mines - Citations and Orders Issued CY 2010-2013
